**Project Aims and Objectives**  
 The project sought to train beneficiaries from North Glasgow in employable ICT skills to an industrial certification standard (BCS-ECDL) and to provide them with relevant Work Experience preparatory to seeking employment. To encourage and sustain participation, beneficiaries received financial support for travel, childcare and subsistence. They also received guidance and counselling, job preparation and search. The partners in the Project were Anniesland College, North Glasgow Housing Association, Balgrayhill Housing Association, Springburn Tenants Association and Glasgow North Ltd. The venue for training was the NGHA Lab suites in Springburn & Possilpark.

<b>Priority/Measure</b>	Objective 3 Programme 2000-06 - Measure 1.1: Raising Employability. This measure aimed to assist those people without jobs, who could quickly return to the labour market, to secure new employment and to assist young people to secure employment, through the provision of appropriate advice, guidance, counselling and training.

**Project Outcomes**  
 A total of 13 individuals undertook training during 2004. Six of these went onto further training and two entered employment at the end of the course. All beneficiaries gained a qualification.  
 The project achieved its outcomes with less expenditure than expected.
